Why a “framework” of indicators?

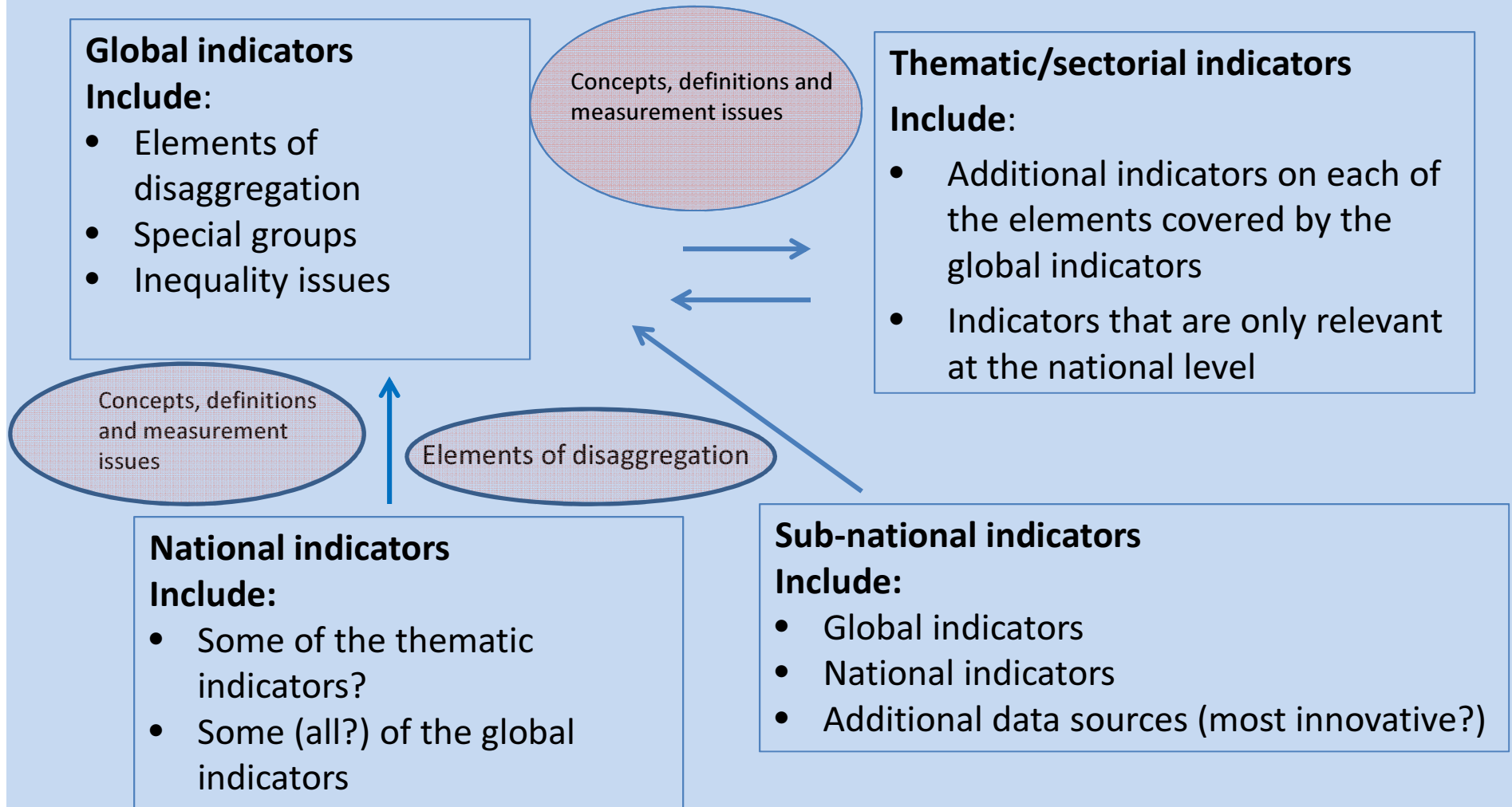
- Global indicators for global monitoring
- National and sub-national indicators
- Additional indicators for “thematic” monitoring

Why global indicators?

Global indicators:

- Inform the global political discussion
- Provide a structure/framework for the development agenda
- Inform communication/advocacy campaigns
- And from the point of view of statistical development:
 - ✓ Consistency and collaboration in data compilation
 - ✓ Harmonization and rationalization of development indicators
 - ✓ Policy-oriented statistics
 - ✓ Framework for coordination of data production and for statistical capacity-building

UNSD as secretariat

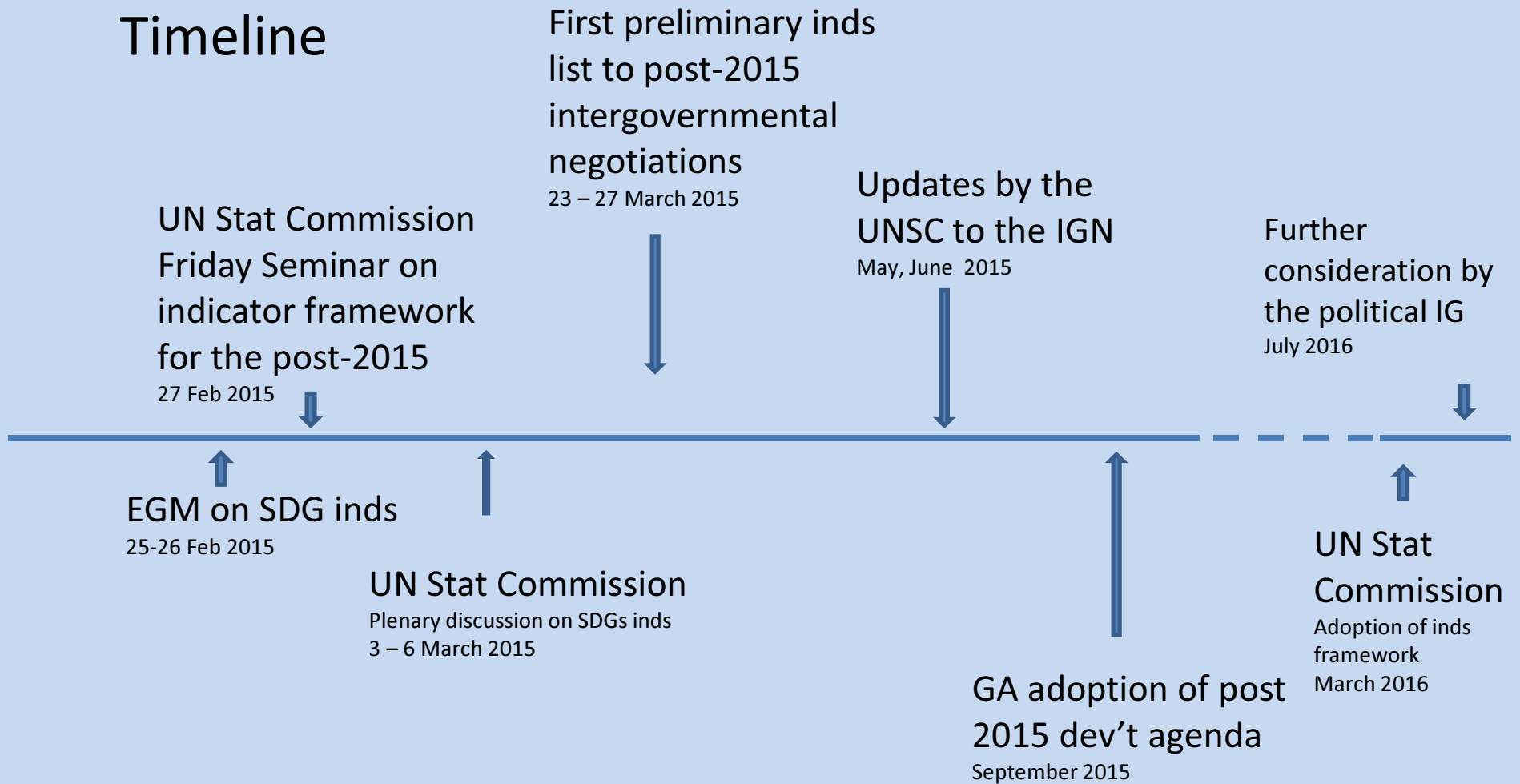
Various monitoring and inter-agency groups
