<p>6.1.1 Proportion of population using safely managed drinking water services</p>	<p>Country coverage is low for Africa, LAC and Asia Pacific.</p>
<p>6.2.1 Proportion of population using safely managed sanitation services, including a handwashing facility with soap and water</p>	<p>There are three data series - safely managed sanitation services, open defecation, and handwashing facility. Data coverage for safely managed sanitation services and handwashing facility are low.</p>
