



# Monitoring and follow up SDGs in Egypt

By:

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- ❑ *Before the launch of the SDGs* in September 2015, Egypt committed itself to achieving sustainable development in the Egyptian constitution (*adopted in January 2014*).
- ❑ The constitution covers the three dimensions of sustainable It contains articles on strengthening governance, equality, and social justice. It is a modern constitution that ensures the constitutional rights of citizens, while guaranteeing that no one is left behind.



## Sustainable Development Strategy -Egypt

- ❑ **Egypt's Vision 2030 (SDS)** was launched during the “Youth Year”, on February 24, 2016, is comprehensive and multidimensional, and ensures the needs of current and future generations.
- ❑ Egypt's Vision 2030 serves as the national umbrella through which the SDGs will be implemented in Egypt. **It reflects the priorities of Egyptians for a better future.**
- ❑ The strategy will be implemented by all stakeholders, including the Government, the private sector, civil society organizations,...etc, in a cohesive approach.





## Sustainable Development Strategy -Egypt

It contains 45 strategic goals that cover each of the three dimensions of sustainable development:

- ❑ **The Economic dimension** has 77 key performance indicators covering all of its four pillars.
- ❑ **The Social dimension** has 61 key performance indicators covering its four pillars.
- ❑ **The Environmental dimension** has 31 key performance indicators covering its two pillars.

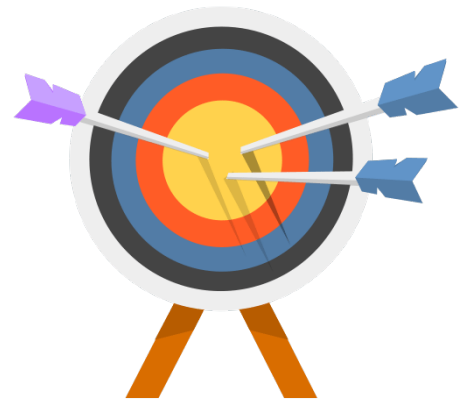

1- Coordinating between the different statistical departments inside NSO (Members of SDU) to obtain data for SDGs.

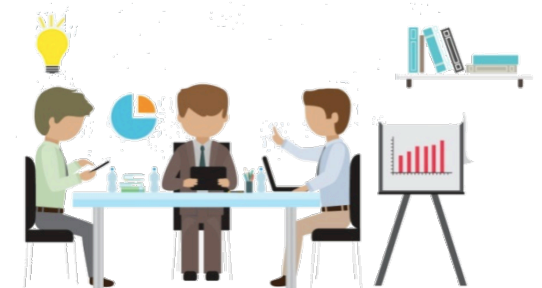
2. Identify the most important challenges that face monitoring SDGs, and build partnerships for this objective .

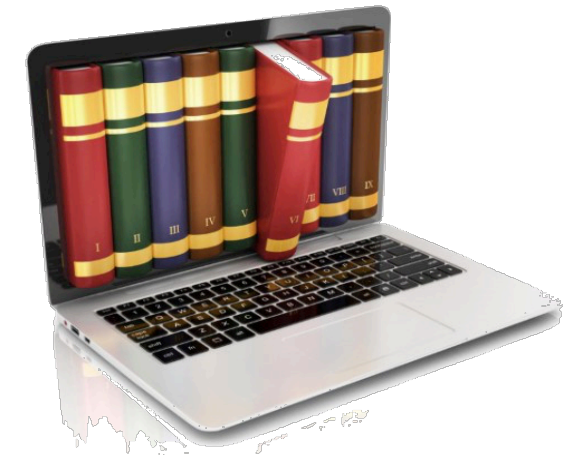


4. Identify the most important capacity-building programs to meet the needs of SDGs.
