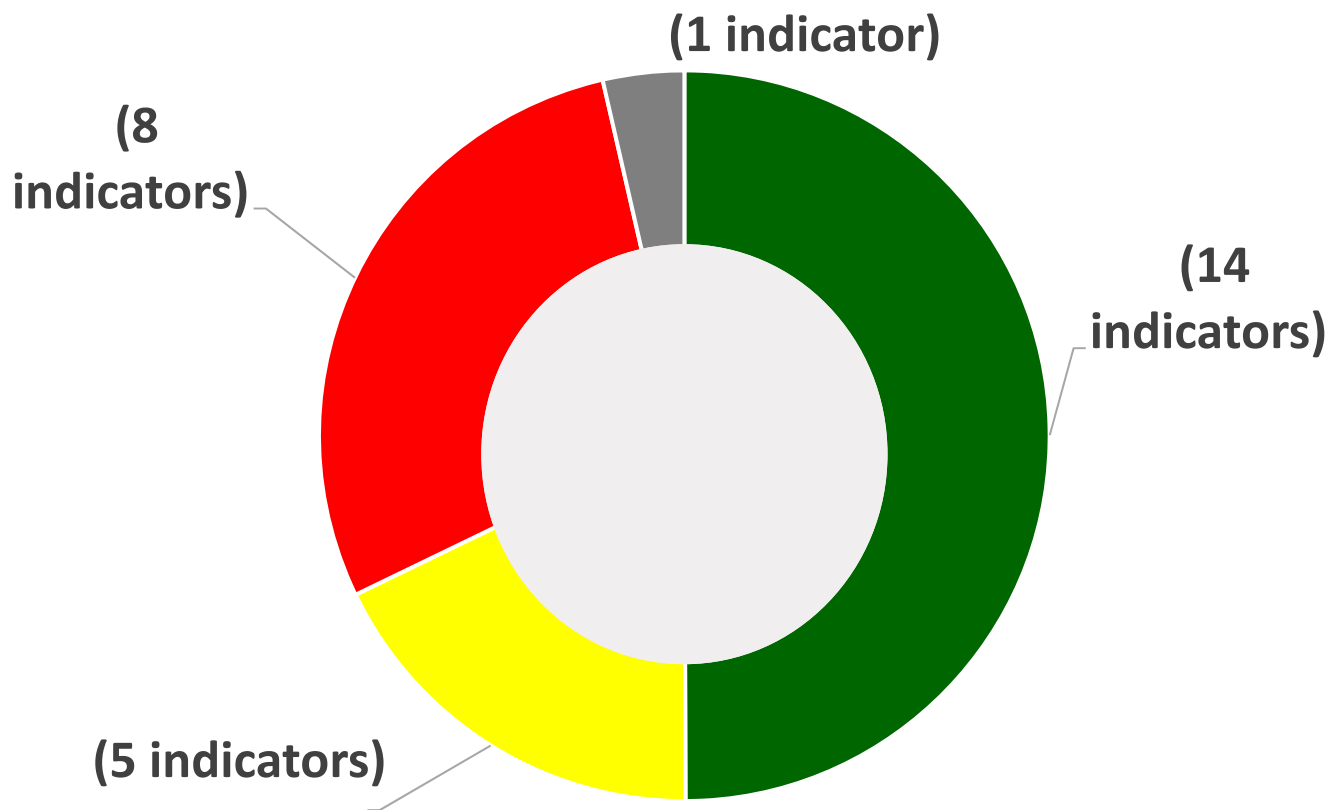

Measuring Indicator 3.6.1

Death rate due to road traffic injuries

Global Definition:

Death rate due to road traffic injuries as defined as the number of road traffic fatal injury deaths per 100,000 population.

Concepts:

Numerator:

Number of deaths due to road traffic crashes. Absolute figure indicating the number of people who die as a result of a road traffic crash.

National

Definition:

The number of deaths caused by land transport accidents per 100,000 population [ICD-10 codes V01-V04, V06, V09-V80, V87, V89, V99]



Measuring Indicator 3.6.1

Death rate due to road traffic injuries

Method of Collection:

Vital Statistics Report (CRVS)

Method of Computation:

(Number of deaths caused by land transport accidents / population) x 100,000

3.6.1 Death rate due to road traffic injuries **0.1** **2016** Vital Statistics Report, PSA



Measuring Indicator 8.6.1

Proportion of youth (aged 15-24) not in education, employment or training

Definition (*Global & National Definition are consistent*): The proportion of youth (aged 15-24 years) not in education, employment or training, also known as "the NEET rate"

Youth not in education are those not enrolled in formal or non-formal education.



Measuring Indicator 8.6.1

Proportion of youth (aged 15-24) not in education, employment or training

Youth not in employment are those *without work & currently available for work & seeking work, or not seeking work due to the following reasons: (a) tired/ believe no work available; (b) awaiting results of previous job application; (c) temporary illness/disability; (d) bad weather; and (e) waiting for rehire/job recall.*

Youth not in training are those who are not in vocational and technical training

Measuring Indicator 8.6.1


Proportion of youth (aged 15-24) not in education, employment or training

Method of computation:

NEET rate = (Total Number of Youth – Total Number of Youth in employment – Total Number of Youth not in employment but in education or training) / Total number of Youth * 100)

Measuring Indicator 17.18.3

Number of countries with a national statistical plan that is fully funded and under implementation, by source of funding

Global Definition: The indicator Number of countries with a national statistical plan that is fully funded and under implementation is based on the annual Status Report on National Strategies for the Development of Statistics (NSDS).

National Definition: 1 if the country satisfies the requirement of the indicator, 0 otherwise



Measuring Indicator 17.18.3

Number of countries with a national statistical plan that is fully funded and under implementation, by source of funding

To present structural and organizational changes in the statistical system

To reflect updates and revisions at the international statistical level in the Philippine Statistical System



To address the data requirements to monitor the PDP and other sectoral plans and regional plans

To incorporate new and emerging statistical innovations and concerns in the PSS
