Regional Challenges



1. Producing Regional Data

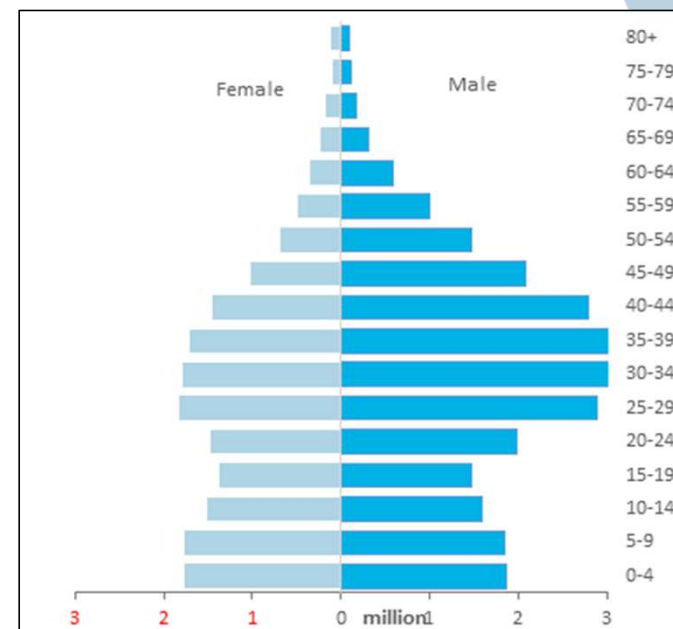
- Capabilities of Information Systems to provide all disaggregations
- Access to micro data for regional disaggregations
- Country implementation paths often mapped to country development plans/priorities

2. Specific Demographic Challenges in Region

- Population mix of GCC Citizens and Non-citizens
- Young Citizen Population
- Non-Citizens concentrated in Working Age Population

➤ **Requires Additional Local Disaggregations**

What happens when a country or region meets an SDG target?



- **Some SDG targets are already met e.g. many SDG targets have already been met at a country level**
 - Goal 1 Poverty
 - Goal 2 Hunger
 - Goal 3 Good Health and Wellbeing
 - Goal 4 Quality Education
 - Goal 6 Water and Sanitation
- How to sustain progress to ensure no one is left behind?
- Should there be national or regional targets beyond regional targets?
- Are extra indicators or disaggregations needed?
