<p>16.3.3</p> <p>Access to dispute resolution mechanisms</p>		<p>Measures accessibility of justice institutions and mechanisms (formal and informal) for civil matters</p>
<p>16.6.2</p> <p>Satisfaction with public services</p>		<p>Measures levels of public satisfaction with last experience of public services, in the three areas of healthcare, education and government services (i.e. IDs and civil registration)</p>
<p>16.7.2</p> <p>Inclusive and responsive decision-making</p>		<p>Measures the extent to which people believe that the government will listen to, and act on, the opinions of citizens</p>

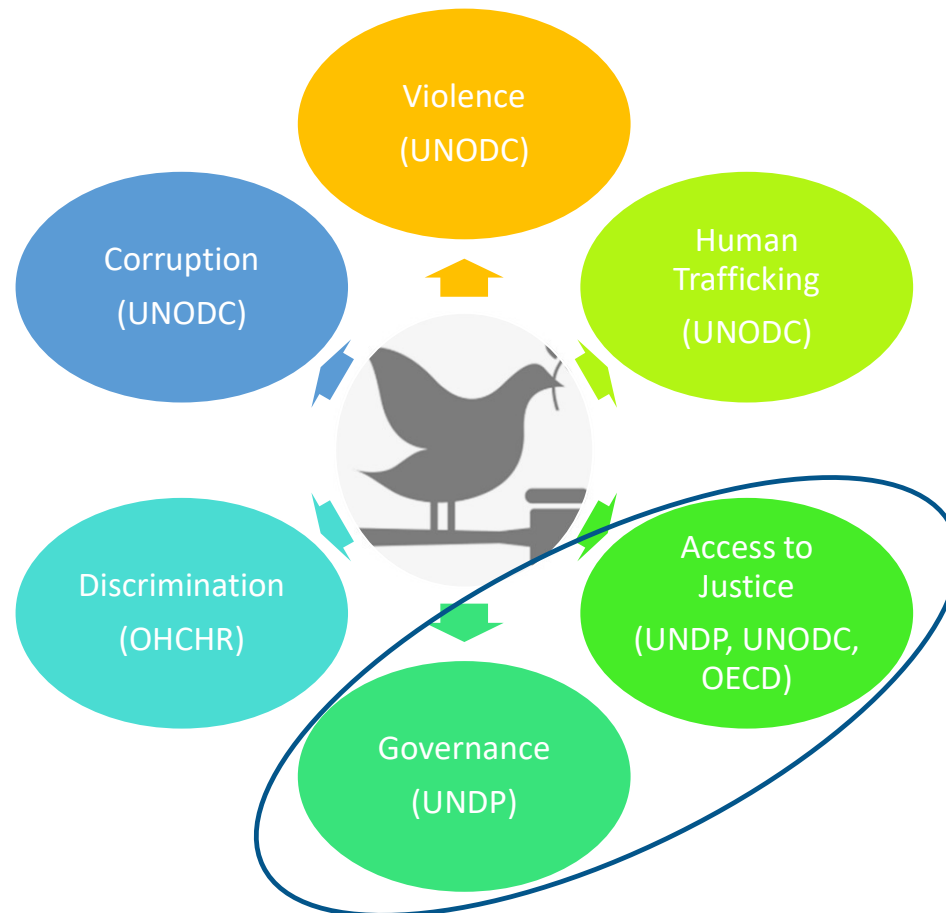

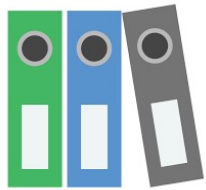
SDG 16 Survey Initiative

- “SDG 16 Survey Module” by UNDP, UNODC and OHCHR: to integrate survey modules in on-going household surveys
- Nine SDG 16 indicators draw on population surveys
- Population surveys = good data source: high data quality, disaggregation
- Challenge for NSOs: regular implementation comes with high costs

Measures the extent to which a country's public service is representative of the general population, with a focus on women, youth, persons with a disability and nationally relevant population groups

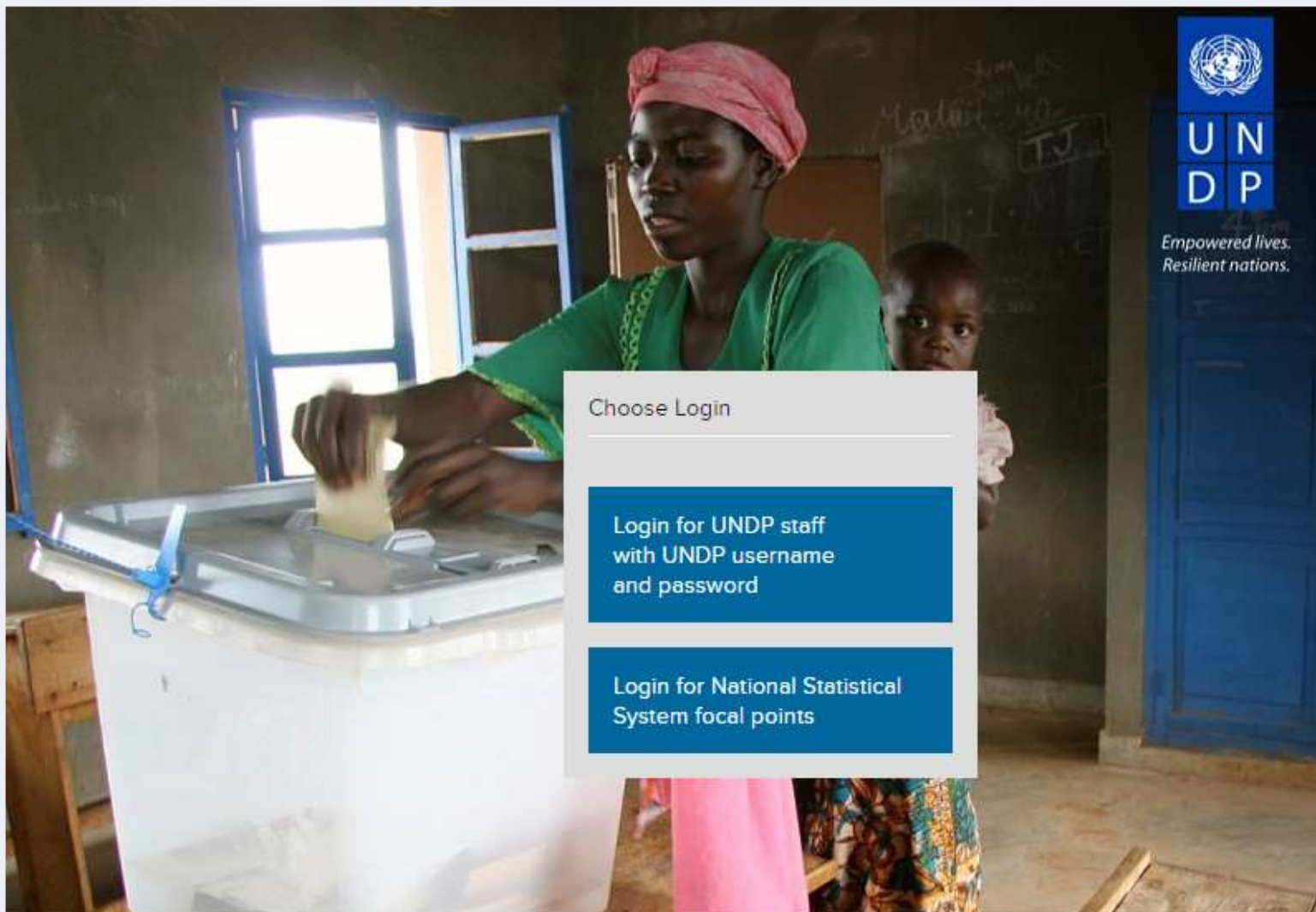

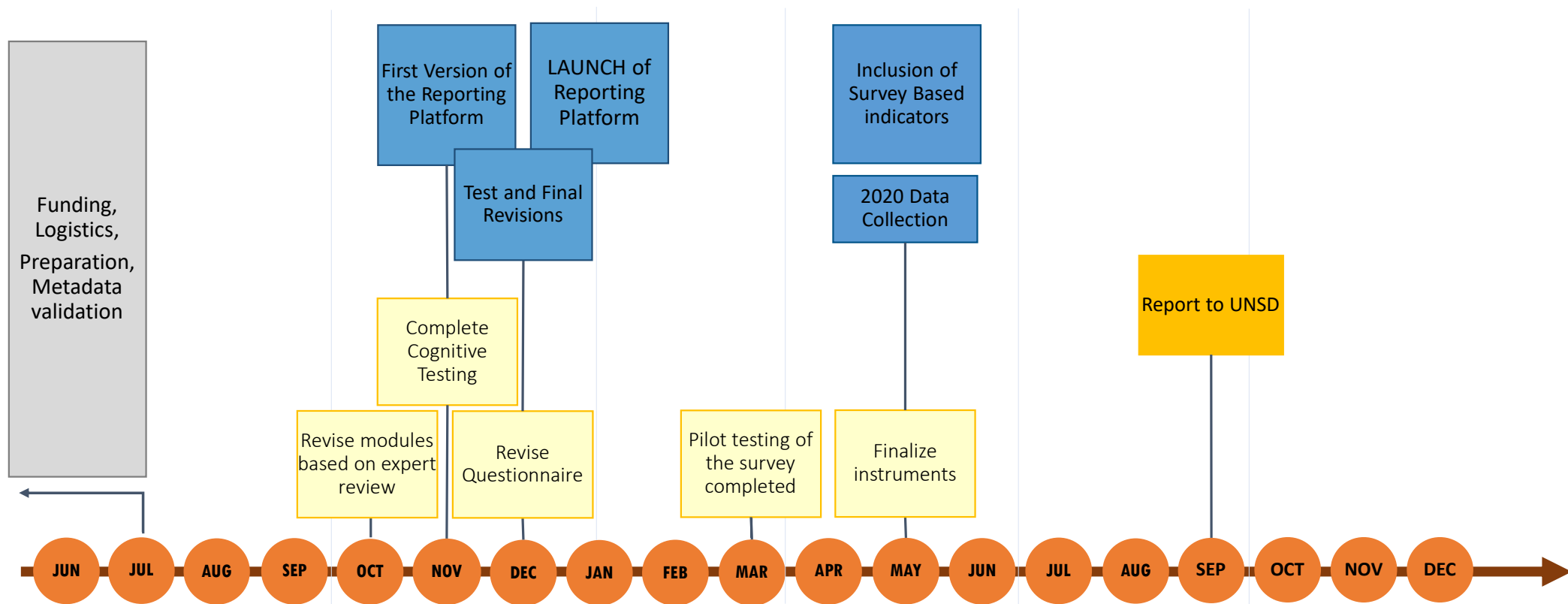
