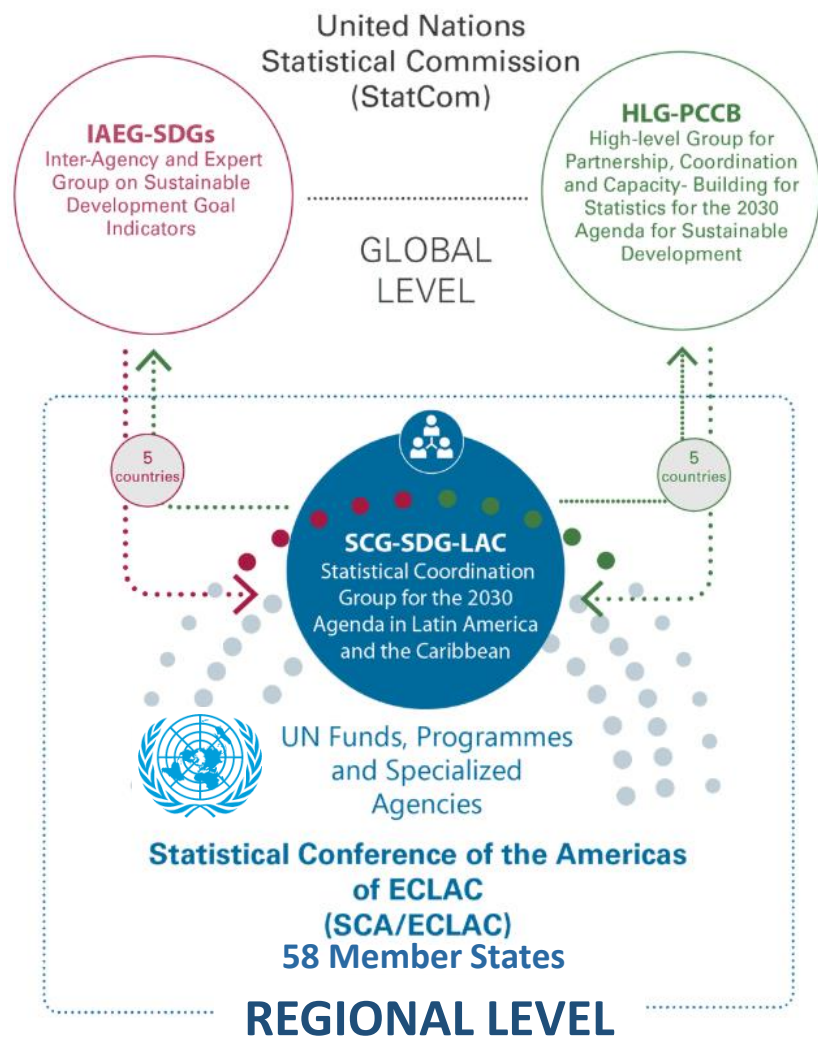

Statistics and Data - Regional Collaborative Platform Group for Latin America and the Caribbean (RCP – LAC)

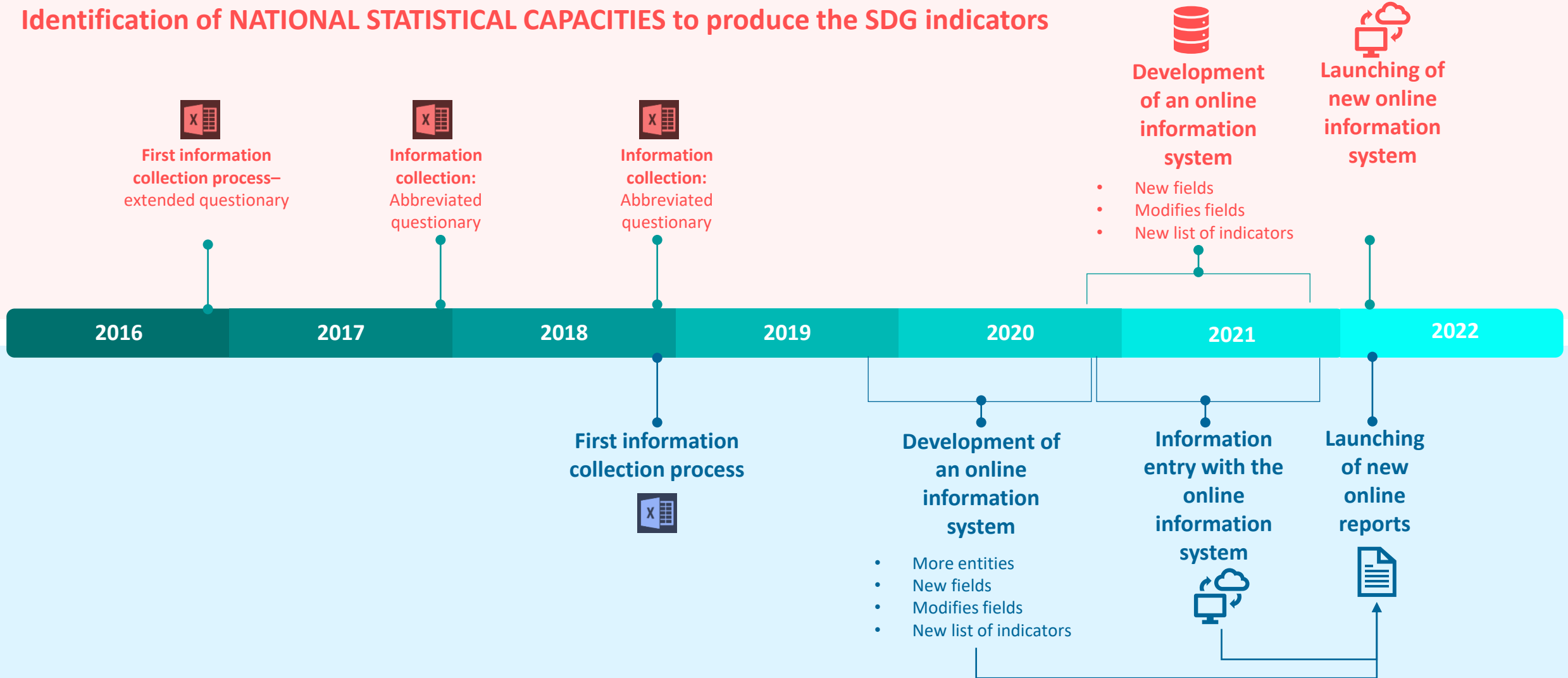

- The main objective of the group is to lead the efforts of the RCP-LAC in the creation and strengthening of alliances for the achievement of the 2030 Agenda and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in the field of statistics.
- The group must coordinate the strategic support given to the countries of the region to strengthening their national statistical systems and national statistical capacities for monitoring the SDG indicators.

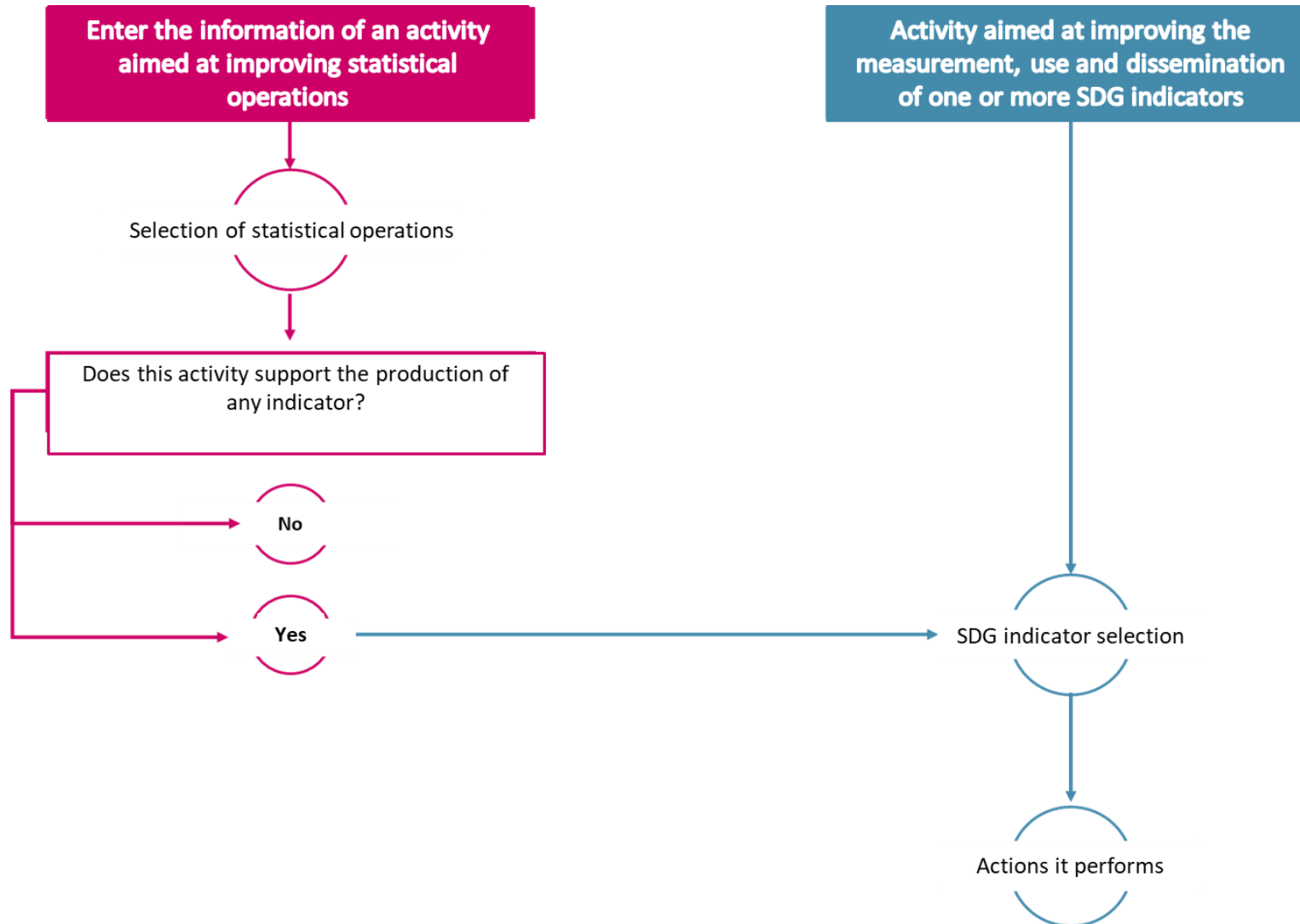

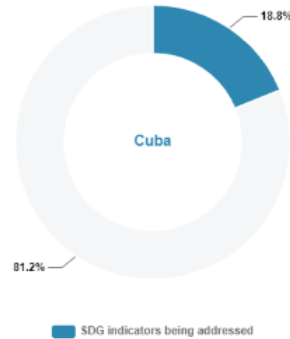

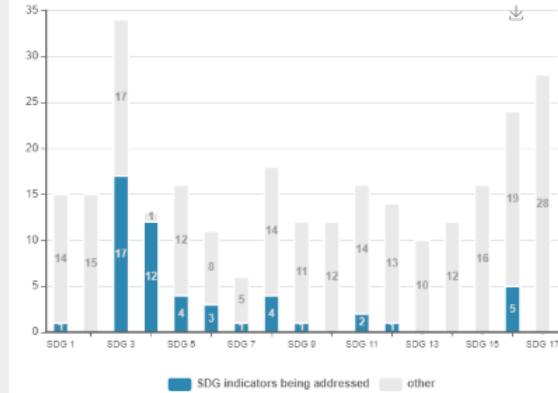

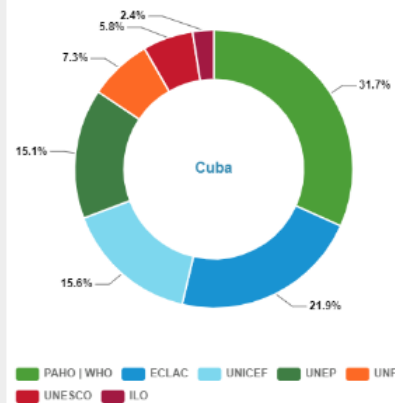
Total number of SDG indicators being addressed by international organizations which include Cuba as a beneficiary country, 2017-2019

Goals being addressed by ILO regarding the SDG indicators during 2017-2019

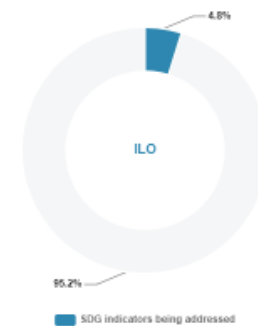


ILO is the custodian agency for 14 indicators of the global indicator framework for the SDGs and participates as a partner body in 3 indicators, being involved in the measurement aspects of 17 indicators that are part of the SDGs 1, 4, 5, 8, 10, 14 and 16. In Latin America and the Caribbean, ILO trains and provides technical assistance to countries on labor statistics and other issues related to decent work, with the aim of strengthening their capacity for planning, compiling and analyzing labor statistics in a wide range of topics including, but not limited to, occupation, underutilization of the workforce, informal employment and social protection. Likewise, the ILO Regional Office focuses on the conceptual and methodological review of the SDG indicators, assisting in the use of international statistical standards such as the latest regulations of the Delhi Group on Informal Sector Statistics and the ICLS / ILO standards.

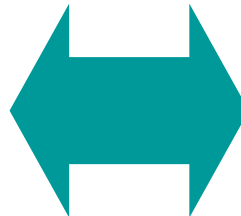
