

#### Capacity development needs assessment

- > One of the 6 sections of the 2023 IAEG-SDGS annual Good Practices Questionnaire on SDG monitoring, Data Disaggregation and Data Gaps includes:
  - Capacity building needs for SDG monitoring (revised in 2023)


### Respondents
