- We are working with Fordham University's [Disability Data Initiative](#) (DDI) to make the internationally comparable data on disability understandable and usable for organizations of persons with disabilities at national and subnational levels.
- The DDI's mission is to provide analyses of disability data to help advance the rights of persons with disabilities and sustainable development for all.
- The DDI makes internationally comparable data on disability publicly available and accessible.
- Each year, DDI produces reports with summaries in Easy Read, Chinese, English, French, Russian, and Spanish.
