## 2.1. Progress and Challenges

#### **Regular Meetings**

- Emergence of a consensus regarding the adoption of a "total external finance" landscape of available resources for developing countries rather than the "additional" component (Domestic resources + ODA).
- Operationalizing the concept of Sustainable
  Development by establishing a set of "overarching criteria" as well as some specific exclusions.
- "additional financial resources...from multiple sources = covering non concessional flows and private?: YES, but it is important to differentiate these flows from others.
- Only flows arriving in developing countries? Yes, but should be looked on a case-by-case basis (e.g. scholarships, in donor refugee costs).
- Incremental approach regarding the inclusion of FDI.
- Research of data availability on BOP statistics

#### **Components of the Research Agenda**

#### 1. South-South Cooperation:

- Significant input from UNCTAD (historic context of the debate on South-South Cooperation→ lack of international consensus).
- Relevance of the input from member countries
- Inclusion of other stakeholders in the discussion (UNOSSC and the South Center).

#### 2. International Public Goods:

- Recognized the contribution of IPG's to Sustainable Development.
- "Political Challenges": Lack of globally accepted operational agreed definition on IPG's
- "Inherent limitations": 17.3 seeks to measure support for developing countries
- Invitation of contributing specific examples in the wiki page.

#### 3. Mobilized Private Finance.

- Inputs from the OECD on the wiki-page
- Case by case analysis regarding the mobilization of [domestic] resources from developing countries.
