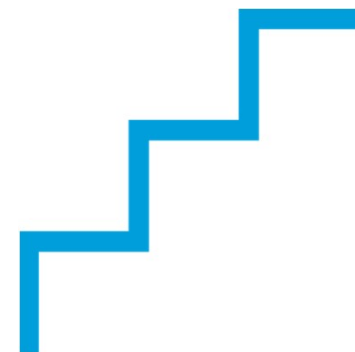

## Compilation of existing tools and resources for data disaggregation

- Since 2015, the **Inter-Agency and Expert Group on SDG Indicators (IAEG-SDGs)**, tasked to develop and implement the global indicator framework for the Goals and targets of the 2030 Agenda, has included work on data disaggregation in its annual activities.<sup>1</sup>
- The IAEG-SDGs developed **a stock-taking questionnaire to identify existing methodologies, guidelines and tools specific** for data disaggregation that have already been developed and agreed by key expert/international groups, mechanisms and committees.
- The participants included established city and expert groups under the UNSC, international expert groups and committees, as well as UN agencies and stakeholders **focusing on vulnerable populations, disaggregation dimensions and data collection methods** (i.e. household surveys, etc.).
