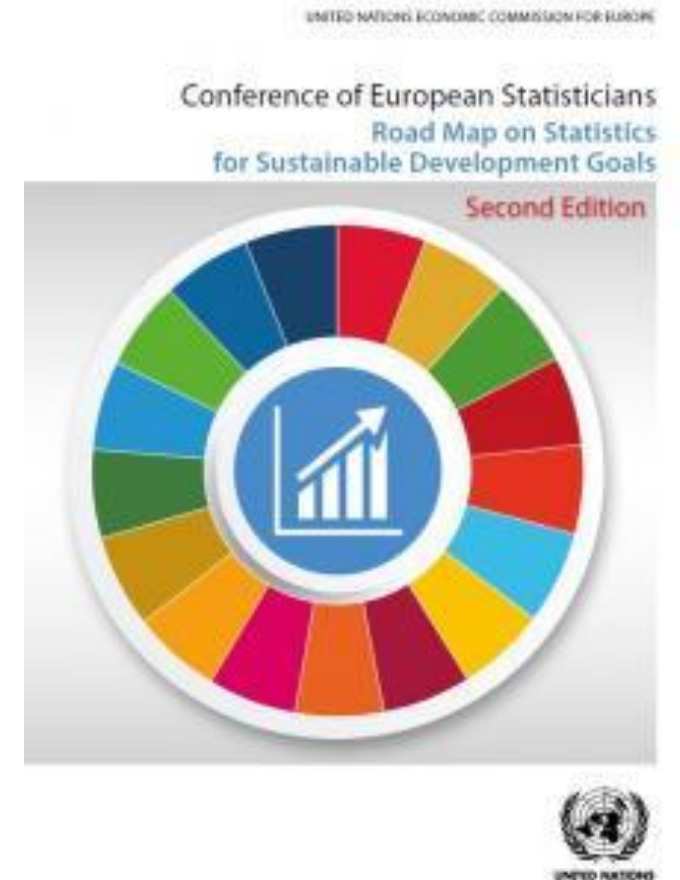


Principal product of the UNECE Steering Group on Statistics for SDGs.

Progress with Road Map recommendations

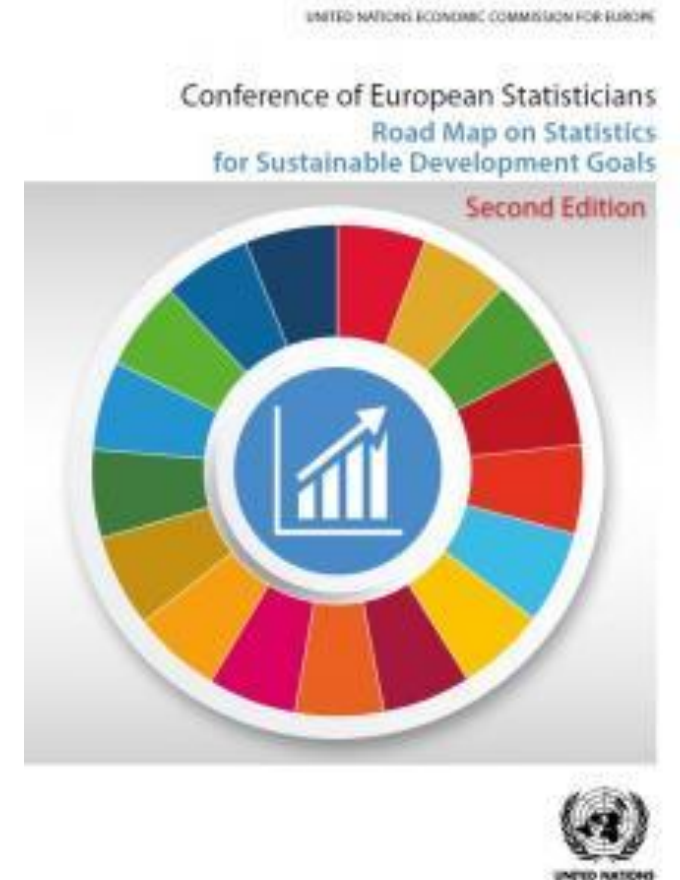


Summary of Progress Table:
