Rationale and Instructions for the Open Consultation

The Inter-Agency and Expert Group on Sustainable Development Goal Indicators (IAEG-SDG) is conducting an open consultation on proposals it is considering as possibly including in the 2020 Comprehensive Review and is seeking the global community's comments on these proposals.

The 2020 Comprehensive Review was mandated by the General Assembly in resolution 71/313 and serves as an opportunity to review the global indicator framework and make improvements. The IAEG-SDG laid out a detailed timeline for the 2020 Comprehensive Review at its 9th meeting in Beirut in March 2019 (http://bit.ly/2020ReviewPresent) that also included specific criteria for any indicator proposals that would be considered. Following this meeting, the group then launched an open call for proposals to be considered in the Review. The compilation of the 2020 comprehensive review proposals received is available on the 2020 Comprehensive review webpage (https://unstats.un.org/sdgs/iaeg-sdgs/2020-comprev/).

The IAEG-SDG has spent much of the past month reviewing these proposals and has developed a list of proposals on which it seeks the input of the global statistical community and this consultation is the opportunity for all interested parties to provide their inputs on these proposals.

The proposals put forth in this consultation take five forms: replacements of existing indicators, revisions of existing indicators, additional indicators, deletions of existing indicators, and in a few cases, requests for proposals for replacing existing indicators where methodological progress or data collection efforts have stalled.

Proposals are divided by Goal, with each Goal having its own section in the consultation. There is no expectation that any individual contributor would provide inputs on all the proposals in this consultation. At the bottom of each page, you can toggle between goals to provide inputs on only those goals that match your interest/expertise.

Please note: There are no proposals for Goals 6 and 9

The IAEG-SDG is requesting inputs from the global statistical community to assist in its deliberations and no decisions (tentative or definitive) have been made on any of the proposals included in this consultation.

For each proposal, the IAEG-SDG invites you to respond whether you believe the proposal should be included in the set of proposals included in the 2020 Comprehensive Review and then asks for any comments you have on the proposal. Links are provided to narratives and metadata provided by the custodian agency for most proposals.

If you submit a proposal for a replacement indicator (in the select cases where such replacements are requested), please make sure the proposal has an agreed methodology and data available. Submitters of these proposals should email metadata (using the metadata template accessible at: (http://bit.ly/Metadata-Template) and a 1 page narrative explaining the rationale for the indicator and how the methodology was approved as an international standard to Benjamin Rae (raeb@un.org). Indicator proposals for which this additional documentation is not received will not be considered by the IAEG-SDG.

The IAEG-SDG will compile and review these comments and proposals, and it will proceed to make further decisions on the proposals to be included in the 2020 Comprehensive Review. A revised set of these proposals would then be presented and discussed at the 10th meeting of the IAEG-SDG in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia in October 2019. Following this meeting, the final list of proposals would be agreed upon and submitted to the United Nations Statistical Commission for consideration at its 51st session in March 2020.
