Brief description of the organization	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> CIS-STAT is the Interstate Statistical Committee of the Commonwealth of Independent States. CIS-STAT was established in accordance with the Decision of the Heads of Governments of the CIS in December 1991 for the coordination of activities of statistical services of the CIS countries, the development of unified statistical methodology in compliance with international standards, securing the comparability of statistical data and rendering assistance to the CIS NSOs.
Mission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Collection and dissemination of the key social and economic statistical data for the CIS countries, comparable in the CIS regional and international context. Harmonization of statistics in the CIS region. Supporting the cooperation of the CIS NSOs.
Fields of Activity / Structure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fields of activity – production of CIS statistics including general and regional data economy and finance, population and social conditions, industries, external trade, environment and energy, science and technology; coordination of the ICP in the CIS region; development of IT solutions in statistics. Structure – four departments: Department of Economic Statistics; Department of Social and Demographic Statistics; Department of Informational Statistical Resources and Technology, Administrative Department.
Mandate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> December 1991: Decision of the Heads of Governments of the Independent States on the advisability to establish a Statistical Committee coordinating the activities of statistical services of the Commonwealth of Independent States; February 1992: Establishment of Statistical Service of the Commonwealth of Independent States; May 1995: new name – Interstate Statistical Committee of the Commonwealth of Independent States (adopted by the Council of the Heads of Governments of the CIS); April 1996: Statute of the Interstate Statistical Committee of the Commonwealth of Independent States adopted (reedited in May 2013)
