# Purpose of Companion Guide

- At an early stage of the ISIC Rev.4 and CPC Ver.2 revision, it was proposed to develop a complimentary publication that can elaborate on individual topics more than what is possible in the introduction or explanatory notes of the classifications



# Purpose of Companion Guide

- Provide background information on the classifications structure
  - e.g. through a more detailed discussion, examples
- Provide information on rationale for chosen structure
  - Useful for national adaptations; future revisions of ISIC and CPC
- Discuss principles and application rules
  - E.g. through more detailed discussion, examples



# Purpose of the Companion Guide

- Discuss application of ISIC and CPC in specific fields
- Provide a more detailed discussion of ISIC and CPC relationship in specific areas
  - Typically related to new or revised concepts



## Structure of Companion Guide

- An outline of the structure has been discussed and approved at the previous EG meeting
- Drafting has followed this recommended structure
  - Therefore no major modifications should be necessary



# Review of the Companion Guide

- Two phases:
  - 1 – review of approach to key components
  - 2 – review of content



## Review – Phase 1

- Should take place at this meeting
- Consider:
  - Is the general scope of information as expected?
    - In particular, for chapters 3.3 and 4.3:
      - Is the breakdown and scope appropriate?
    - For chapter 3.1:
      - Is the detail and style of information appropriate?



# Review – Phase 1

## Consider:

- Is the type of information selected appropriate?
- In particular, for chapters 5 and 6:
  - Is the selection of topics appropriate?
  - Should additional topics be added?
    - If so, who can provide a draft version?





## Review – Phase 2

- ❑ Should include a review of the detailed content of the chapters of the Guide
- ❑ While work on original draft was limited to TSG members, the review can be undertaken by others as well
- ❑ Need to set a timetable for review and assign responsibilities



## Questions for EG – summary

- Review format and scope of draft text for existing chapters (3.1, 3.3, 4.3)
- Review components of chapters 5 and 6
  - Suggest amendments if necessary
- Agree on review process for detailed content
  - Timetable
  - Assignments to “volunteers”
