INTRODUCTION

In accordance with a recommendation of the Statistical Commission of the United Nations at its 17th session, in 1972, a world-wide inquiry on national practices in the definition, collection, compilation and uses of internal migration statistics has been undertaken by the Statistical Office of the United Nations. The study was conducted by sending a questionnaire (see Annex) to each national statistical office and the replies are summarized in three tables presented in this document, showing national practices in regard to (1) the concepts used, (2) types of data collected, compiled and published and (3) national uses of data on internal migration. This document is being circulated to national statistical offices so that they may provide clarifications and/or corrections of the information shown in the tables. The summary responses contained herein must therefore be considered provisional.<sup>1/</sup>

An earlier document based on a companion study of national practices in connexion with international migration statistics, "National Practices in the Definition, Collection and Compilation of Statistics of International Migration" (ST/ESA/STAT/80), has already been circulated and is currently being revised on the basis of the comments and/or corrections received.
