I. Population

1. The Population was counted on the basis of the so-called de jure population concept. The de jure population refers to those persons who usually live in an area before and after the date of census.
2. Although the following persons were away from home at the census, they were enumerated at the place of usual residence of their family.
 - a) Civilians who were away from home for business or travel. = e
 - b) Those who were in a police station or detention house (not a penitentiary).
 - c) Those who were involved in the military reserve corps during civilian defence exercises. = c
 - d) In-patients of hospitals and their attendants.
3. Those who were absent and could not be classified in any one of the above categories due to unknown reasons were enumerated at the place of usual residence of their family in cases where the duration of absence was less than one month.
4. The following persons were enumerated in the special enumeration districts and were allocated to place of usual residence of their family.
 - a) Persons in a penitentiary or a juvenile detention house.
 - b) Military personnel residing in their camps. = c
 - c) Those residing in police camps.
 - d) Korean diplomats and their dependents abroad. = c
5. The following persons were excluded from the enumeration.
 - a) Workers and students who were living abroad at the time of the census. g
 - b) Foreigners working in diplomatic and consular offices in Korea and in offices of the Korean mission of the United Nations and their dependents.
 - c) Foreign military personnel, military civilians and their dependents.

II. Urban / Rural

All Shis(cities) which include 50,000 persons or more respectively are defined as Urban, where as all Guns(counties) are defined as Rural.

III. All data shown here include both Koreans and foreigners.
