- Then will write children (unmarried);
- If there are several couple in the household at first will write the first couple with theirs unmarried children, and then will write another couple with theirs children and so on;
- The members of household which does not has any relation with the other members of family, they will write at the end (like gardener, nanny, cook and other which are living in the household).
