## Some explanations about the tables

### Table 1B

#### 1. Usual resident population includes:

1. Persons who had an official (legal) place of residence in the Republic of Macedonia, regardless whether at the time of the Census they were present at their official place of residence or elsewhere in the Republic of Macedonia;
2. Persons who had a residence permit in the Republic of Macedonia, and had been temporarily present in the Republic of Macedonia for at least one year, but who had an official (legal) place of residence outside the Republic of Macedonia, with the exception of refugees and persons under humanitarian care;
3. Persons who had an official (legal) place of residence in the Republic of Macedonia, who at the time of the Census and for a maximum of one year prior to its conduct, were temporarily working abroad, and the members of their families; and
4. Persons who had an official (legal) place of residence in the Republic of Macedonia, who at the time of the Census, were working at diplomatic and consular representative offices of the Republic of Macedonia abroad, at the United Nations and its organisations, at representative offices or representatives of the Chamber of Commerce abroad, business offices abroad, military personnel of the Republic of Macedonia abroad, and also citizens engaged in international, technical and other kinds of co-operation and education and members of other families who were staying temporarily abroad with the aforesaid persons.

#### 2. Item i : Usual resident population in the country at the time of the census includes:

1. Persons who had an official (legal) place of residence in the Republic of Macedonia, regardless whether at the time of the Census they were present at their official place of residence or elsewhere in the Republic of Macedonia;
2. Persons who had a residence permit in the Republic of Macedonia, and had been temporarily present in the Republic of Macedonia for at least one year, but who had an official (legal) place of residence outside the Republic of Macedonia, with the exception of refugees and persons under humanitarian care;
3. Persons who had an official (legal) place of residence in the Republic of Macedonia, who at the time of the Census, were working at diplomatic and consular representative offices of the Republic of Macedonia abroad, at the United Nations and its organisations, at representative offices or representatives of the Chamber of Commerce abroad, business offices abroad, military personnel of the Republic of Macedonia abroad, and also citizens engaged in international, technical and other kinds of cooperation and education and members of other families who were staying temporarily abroad with the aforesaid persons.

3. Item ii : Usual resident population not in the country at the time of the census includes:

Persons who had an official (legal) place of residence in the Republic of Macedonia, who at the time of the Census and for a maximum of one year prior to its conduct, were temporarily working abroad, and the members of their families

4. Item iii : Non- resident population, present in the country at the time of the census includes:

Persons who had a residence permit in the Republic of Macedonia, and had been temporarily present in the Republic of Macedonia less than one year, refugees and persons under humanitarian care; all these persons had an official (legal) place of residence outside the Republic of Macedonia.

5. Item iv is sum of items i, ii and iii.

#### **Table 1C and 1D**

The term "urban population" covers the population which has an official place of residence in urban settlements and settlements which as urban units have been integrated into urban settlements.

The term "other population" covers the population which has an official place of residence in other settlements (different than urban)

The division of the settlements in the two groups urban and others is stated in the Act for the territorial division. (We can not give a definition)

**The data in the tables refers the usual resident population of the Republic of Macedonia. Because of the boycott by 0.6 % from the population, in the tables, there are two figures for the usual resident population. In tables 1B, 1C, 1D and 16 are given data on total usual resident population (actually enumerated and estimated non-enumerated population). In the rest of the tables, data refers only on actually enumerated population.**
