- Une résidence secondaire est un logement utilisé pour les week-ends, les loisirs ou les vacances.
- Un logement vacant est un logement inoccupé : proposé à la vente, à la location, ou en passe de l'être ; déjà attribué à un acheteur ou un locataire et en attente d'occupation ; en attente de règlement de succession ; gardé vacant et sans affectation précise par le propriétaire (exemple un logement très vétuste...) ; conservé par un propriétaire pour un usage futur au profit d'un employé, de parents, d'amis ; non habité par suite du départ de l'occupant dans une communauté (maison de retraite...).
