Results of the AEG e-discussion on Ships' crew and patients

Introduction

1. The treatment of ships' crew and long-term patients was covered in the AEG paper (SNA/M2.04/20) on residence of households but conclusions on their treatment were not made at the December 2004 AEG meeting. The paper (SNA/M1.05/15.3) solicits the opinion of the AEG members on ships' crew and patients through e-discussion. It proposes to retain the existing treatment of both the *SNA* and *BPM5*. That is, the residence of ships' crew and medical patients is based on the location of a dwelling place other than on the ship or place of medical treatment, respectively.
