	measures of GDP"). There are many countries with advanced NA systems which cannot really compile all the three approaches originally and complete,	
	although it is pretended to do so. Therefore the text should read as follows:	
	"In practice in many countries it may not be possible to compile all three measures of GDP. But it seems to be necessary to compile al least two approaches in order to have a real balancing procedure and not only a simple one step approach. Indeed, it happens"	
18.37	5 <sup>th</sup> line: Sentence in brackets should be deleted (because shares are not part of inventories).	

18.48	2 <sup>nd</sup> sentence is not clear: ("However, definitions in section B…"). What is meant here?
18.49	4 <sup>th</sup> line: <b>developed</b>
