Page 2/ Point II	Preparation of the 2020 Population and Housing Census	<p>BPS Indonesia is planning to implement innovative measures to conduct the 2020 Population and Housing Census. These measures are among others:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Using CAPI in parts or the whole of Indonesia (Tablets, smartphones or laptops) for digital mapping and data capture in selected statistical areas. - Conducting census by register (incorporating the administrative population data into the census and link it by using the NIK, a kind of social security number unique to every persons in Indonesia) - Efficiency of data capture by reverting to short form (in the 2010 Census the use of long form was considered too complicated and time consuming to implement) - To fully implement field verification of cases of maternal death (proxy pregnancy- related death). The government of Indonesia has designated the census as a vehicle for capturing cases of maternal death. During the 2010 Census verification procedure was not fully implemented due to lack of funding - In the 2020 Population Census, Indonesia planned to include the question on international out-migration for the first time. On the 2015 Intercensal Population Survey, BPS Statistics Indonesia included this kind of questions but the result is not sufficient to be published. <p>There will be a series of try outs and pilot surveys to test these innovations prior to the field implementation of the 2020 Population Census</p>
Page 2/ Point II	Population projection using the 2020 Population Census Data	<p>New methods of calculating population projection using probabilistic approach (such as Bayesian approach), instead of the traditional deterministic demographic component method. The use of the probabilistic model must be applied not just for national level, but also sub-national level. The current Bayesian model applied by the UN for population projection is only at country level. However, there is a need for capacity building because the method has never been attempted before in BPS-Statistics Indonesia.</p>
