As part of another large-scale project, Development Account 10th Tranche, UN Regional Commissions and UNSD will conduct a series of workshops and training events on SDMX implementation in the context of SDGs. UNSD is also undertaking a number of capacity building activities in conjunction with the implementation of SDMX for IMTS.</p>	<p>BPS Statistics Indonesia has developed a system information management of metadata, named SIRUSA (sirusa.bps.go.id) or system of statistical reference. Metadata classified into three categories: activity metadata, indicator metadata and variable metadata. Unfortunately, the metadata not on SDMX-based dissemination format. Capacity building to migration between metadata existing into SDMX format would be useful for develop standards for exchange and sharing of data BPS.</p>
