

# **UNFPA Support – the "why"?**

- Population data is key for evidence—based planning & decision making:
  - 98 of the 232 unique SDG indicators require population data
  - Population data required for to locate those at risk of being "left behind".
  - The census underpins national data ecosystems, & provides master sampling frames for household surveys
- In many countries, the census remains the primary source of population data









### **UNFPA** goal



- a) to strengthen the capacity of national statistical systems to collect, process and disseminate georeferenced census data; and
- b) to assure full utilization of census data to inform and monitor the achievement of subnational, national and global development agendas

Adoption of innovative census technologies & methodologies

- Digital cartography
- Use of handheld devices for enumeration
- Use of satellite imagery to estimate population in areas where enumeration is not possible – "hybrid census"





### Greater use of georeferenced census data:

- Data integration & use-case generation
- Generating demographic intelligence from census data
  - Mapping national development indicators at lower geographic levels e.g. child marriage
  - Sub-national projections,
  - Small Area Estimates of development indicators/SDGs

#### Wider dissemination of census data:

- Accessible dashboards, portals, and GIS-based platforms
- Dynamic Online Interactive Live Mapping & Spatial-Analysis
