Partner country attribution



- Country of origin for import statistics
- Country of last known destination for export statistics
- Country of consignment, in addition

Example: Export Canada to Mexico



- Canada Export to Mexico via USA Ports
- Country of Final Destination: Mexico
- Country of Consignment: USA
- Country of Origin: Canada

However, Canadian exporters could assume Country of Final Destination: USA

Country Practice: China, Hong Kong SAR

HK offers assembling and testing for electronic toys in plastic casing

This is inward processing

HK changes criteria country of origin if

- o **Assembled in Hong Kong and**
- Containing 25% Hong Kong cost content attributable to local component parts and labor

If those criteria are not met, HK registers trade as re-export, otherwise export

Rules of Origin

'Rules of origin as established by each country':

- 'wholly obtained' in case only one country involved
- 'substantial transformation' in other cases provide documentary evidence of origin direct consignment (required by several countries)
- cumulative origin (allowed by several countries under certain conditions)

Momentary under review (harmonization) by 'Committee on Rules of Origin' (WTO) and 'Technical Committee on Rules of Origin' (WCO)
