REGIONAL SEMINAR ORGANIZATION AND COORDINATION

1. The seminar is organized by the United Nations Statistics Division, New York, in collaboration with UN Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (ESCWA), Center for Economic and Social Research and Training Centre for Islamic Countries (SESRIC), the Jordan Department of Statistics and the Arab Institute for Training and Research in Statistics (AITRS).

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VENUE & DATE OF THE SEMINAR

- 2. The Seminar will be held at the Days Inn, Amman from 12-14 June 2012.
- 3. The inaugural session will be convened at 08:00 am on Thursday, 12 June 2012. On 13, and 14 June 2012, sessions of the seminar will be from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm and from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm.

LANGUAGE

4. The Seminar will be conducted in English with Arabic simultaneous interpretation provided by the United Nations.

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WEATHER

The weather in Amman in June is relatively warm during the day, moderate overnight, where the temperature ranges from 28 to 32 degrees Celsius during day time and averages around 15 degrees Celsius during the night.

TRANSPORT FROM AND TO AIRPORT

- 11. Participants should make their own transportation arrangements from Queen Alia International Airport to their respective hotels. Taxi services are readily available at the airport. Participants may access public taxis by exiting the arrival hall right after they pick-up their travel bags. Taxi charges range from JD 20 to 25 (equivalent to about US\$ 30-35).
- 12. Bus services are also available only from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm and pick passengers from the airport to the North Bus Station. Participants can take a taxi from there to their respective hotels. The charge from the airport by bus to the bus station is JD 3 (equivalent to about US\$ 5) and from the station to hotel is JD 3 (equivalent to about US\$5) rate of exchange: One JD = US\$ 1.41

13. Participants, choosing to stay in other hotel than the one at where the sessions will be held, should have to make their own transport arrangements for attending the Seminar.
