# EMPLOYMENT IN TOURISM - BAHAMAS

- The Labor Force Survey Results – Employment by Industrial Classification is used for the following:
  - Accommodations
  - Food And Beverage Serving Industry
  - Passenger Transport (Road, Water, Air)
  - Travel Agencies
  - Sports and Recreation
  - *Country Specific Tourism Industries:*
    - Real Estate



# EMPLOYMENT IN TOURISM - BAHAMAS

- For some of the Tourism Industries the Labor Force numbers are adjusted by the portion of that Industry that represents Tourism. These include:
  - Country Specific Tourism Industries
    - Straw Market
    - Other Business Services



# EMPLOYMENT IN TOURISM - BAHAMAS

- For Casinos – Country Specific Tourism Industry we use the data directly from the Gaming Board. These individuals work at the hotel but are employed by a separate entity that is overseen by the a Government Regulated Board.



## FUTURE PLANS

- Number of Establishments in Tourism Industries
  - Business Establishment Register- Expansion to separate number of employees by Male and Female
  - Number of Employees for the Industries currently calculated using Labor Force Survey can be extracted using the Business Establishment Register adjusted for Male and Female using the LFS ratios.
