

Data Sources for Cash BOP – controlled by Central Bank (BNM)



Empowers BNM to collect any necessary information for maintaining the records of balance of payments and international investment position

- Cash flow records for economic transactions between residents and non-residents, which are effected through the domestic banking system
- Inter-company accounts record all payables and receivables between resident and non-resident companies arising from offsetting arrangements
- Overseas accounts record resident companies' debits and credits with non-resident banks

Cash vs Accrual Recording

Differences in timing of recording and change of ownership

Cash Basis


- revenues are recognised when cash is received and deposited
- expenses are recorded in the accounting period when bills are paid
- transactions recorded may be net flows

Accrual Basis

- income is realised in the accounting period in which it is earned regardless of when the cash from these fees is received
- expenses are recorded as they are owed (e.g. when supplies are ordered, the printer finishes your brochure, employees actually perform the work, etc.), instead of when they are paid
- transactions recorded on gross flows




Quarterly Survey of ITS 1 Transport

Data Collection Methodology

The methodology for data collection is through a standard questionnaire. The questionnaire is sent to respondents on a quarterly basis. This survey is also conducted via web based.
