The fourth, revised edition of the paper entitled: “Toponymic guidelines for map editors and other editors: Finland”, presented at the twenty-second session of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names, held in New York in 2004, has been updated (version 4.12, April 2023).

The updates concern the distribution of the population and languages across Finland (section 1, on languages), and the names of the new administrative units (well-being services counties) and their areas of operation (section 6, on administrative divisions).
