Background

The International Council of Onomastic Sciences (ICOS), the global umbrella organization of all sciences contributing to the field of onomastics, established in 2024 a Working Group on Toponymy as its third WG. In the framework of the 28th International Congress of Onomastic Sciences, 19–23 August 2024, Helsinki, Finland, this WG held its first business meeting electing Peter Jordan (Austria) Chair and Chrismi-Rinda Loth (South Africa) Vice-Chair of the WG. In the meantime, the WG has 60 members from 32 countries and all continents. A major task of the WG is organizing sessions at international congresses and conferences as well as cultivating contacts with other global organizations in the field of toponymy such as UNGEGN, or related to this field like ICA or IGU.

Objective

This meeting will present the tasks and aims of this WG, its activities since its foundation in 2024 as well as its activities planned for the remaining year 2025. It will also be an opportunity to present and discuss ideas for future activities including events and scientific projects as well as to exchange information between participants.
