Progress in WGND



- World Geographical Name Database (WGND) : A repository of the short and full names of countries for capitals and cities in multi-lingual, multi-scriptal and georeferenced format
- Endonyms for city by national names authorities and sound files are added
- Currently, toponyms more than 2,700 country names, 12,000 names for upwards of 9,850 cities and more than 970 audio files



Expansion of WGND

Guided by the UNGEGN Decision 3/2023/18

- UN Demographic Yearbook additional **2,735 cities** (English and French)
- UN Gazetteer additional 5,550 cities

Further,

- Coordination with resources in the Secretariat, such as UNTERM database, UNlibrary, Global Sustainable Development Goal Indicators Database, etc.
- Integration of Universal Unique IDentifier (UUID)










• UN Second Administrative Level Boundary (SALB) Programme
