Volunteered Geographic Information and Linked Open Data in national geographical names standardization

Summary **

Volunteered Geographic Information (VGI) and Linked Open Data (LOD) are relatively new techniques to collect and store geographical data. In the past decade various countries have developed activities in which they applied crowdsourcing to collect geographical names, resulting in VGI use cases. More recently, the first examples of LOD applications have been discussed.

The report summarizes VGI and LOD activities that have been reported to the past UNGEGN sessions and identifies good practices for these techniques.
