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Report of the Working Group on Romanization Systems: current status of United Nations romanization systems for geographical names

Summary**

The report of the Working Group on Romanization Systems provides information on the main developments in respect of the status of romanization systems on the agenda of the Working Group, focusing on the romanization or writing systems for Kazakh, Lao, Sinhala and Uzbek.

Also provided is information on developments pertaining to actions of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names strategic plan and programme of work 2021–2029, in particular action 1-iii-10 relating to innovative methods for romanization. A request is also made to members of the Group of Experts for information on the use of romanization systems in their national contexts.
