## Report of Ukraine

## Summary\*\*

The report covers activities in Ukraine on the standardization of geographical names. During the intersessional period 2023–2024, the State Service of Ukraine for Geodesy, Cartography and Cadastre<sup>1</sup> conducted activities in the following main areas:

- Improving the legislative framework for activities relating to geographical names
- Creating and updating the State Register of Geographical Names
- Utilizing and maintaining geographical names
- Engaging in international cooperation on geographical names

Information is provided on changes in Ukrainian legislation on geographical names and the administrative and territorial structure of Ukraine. Also included is information on the updating of the State Register of Geographical Names with the names of geographical objects in Ukraine (about 105,500 geographical names) and the creation of the second part of the State Register with the names of geographical objects of other States that are used in Ukraine (over 80,000 geographical names of foreign countries).
