Geographical names data management at the Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics

Summary**

The report surveys the following activities of the Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics:

- Use of geospatial information system applications to collect, update, document and manage geographical names in the Arab Republic of Egypt;
- Creation and update of integrated geospatial and statistical databases in support of the State's sustainable development and digital transformation efforts.

The report covers the national project to integrate the spatial information infrastructure of the Egyptian planning system, including the following:

- Integration of spatial data layers for government agencies;
- Establishment of a standardized base map for the national spatial data infrastructure;
- Standardization of geospatial standards, data interoperability and exchange of geospatial data between producers and users.
