Report of Burundi

Summary**

Following its participation in the 2023 session of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names, held in New York from 1 to 5 May 2023, Burundi set to work implementing the recommendations of that session. It has therefore drawn up an annual work plan and budget for the standardization of geographical names. The plan includes workshops, meetings and activities to geolocalize the toponyms selected in Gitega Province in relation to the tourist sites already inventoried.
