Report of Chad

Summary**

The standardization of geographical names, as with many other scientific and administrative activities, has been on the back burner in Chad since the political transition of April 2021. Priority was given, within the framework of the inclusive and sovereign national dialogue, to the organization of the elections that were held in May 2024. The mapping of the entire national territory conducted as a prelude to those legislative, provincial and communal elections has made it possible to collect and update many geographical names that will be used for the third general population and housing census.
