

International names standardization

Sweden - names in Swedish and outside Sweden

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Lantmäteriet determines official place names (legally binding for public use)

Names exist in Swedish, Sámi, Meänkieli, and Finnish; used in parallel in multilingual areas

Swedish is the principal language, per the Swedish Language Act
